The Public Transportation service is provided to the general public, including persons with disabilities, by reservation in communities of Furnas and Red Willow counties. Everyone is eligible to ride.

ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE END OF EACH RIDE

EXCEPTIONS: Tri Valley Public Transportation will provide services to eligible riders in accordance with an agreement between TVHS and the Department of Health & Human Services. All scheduled trips require preauthorization from Intelliride (**prior to pick-up**). All related fees will be billed to Intelliride. Otherwise, payment based on the current rate will be required directly from the rider.

26 - 40	\$8.00	\$16.00
41 - 50	\$9.25	\$18.50
51 - 60	\$10.00	\$20.00
>60 miles	55¢ per mile each rider +\$20 round trip cost	

For out of town trips up to 60 miles maximum, individuals riding to assist the scheduled rider during their trip will not be charged.

Regular fees will be charged if additional stops are requested by the individual providing the assistance or in some way benefits them. For out of town trips beyond the 60 miles limit, individuals riding to assist the scheduled rider will be charged an additional \$5.00
